Fr. Duncan writes: Thank you for your comments and the offers of support to help the SVP in South Ruislip with their work supporting people in great need. At our recent SVP meeting, we discussed the developing situation facing many people in our local area who may be struggling to feed their families and heat their homes. St Gregory's SVP run a food bank. They get great support from the Hillingdon Food bank, which we have been supporting during Advent and Lent for a number of years. But, (there is always a BUT!) they are often short of specific items. It was proposed that we here at Most Sacred Heart, offer to help them. They are particularly short of cleaning materials, washing up liquid, scouring pads, washing powder/tablets, dishcloths and carrier bags. When you are shopping this week, could you pick up something from this list to donate. They do not need food items at present. Some of our SVP members will be going down to help the SVP on distribution days and they will monitor the situation as it develops. As we have seen in the news, the need is most certainly going to increase. We may not be rich, but anything we can do will be of enormous help. There is a box in the foyer to receive donations. Covid19 Procedures in Church

Now that the Government has removed some of the restrictions put in place to control the spread of the Covid virus, it is more important than ever we do our best to keep ourselves, our family and friends safe.
