3rd Sunday of Easter

Now the Easter Celebrations are over and the new term is well under way, our thoughts turn to the Confirmations in July and the Parish First Holy Communions this month.

First Holy Communion Preparation

This week we have the final preparation session for children in Groups 3 and 4 (5pm-6pm and 6:15pm-7:15pm) in the Coffee Lounge on TUESDAY 3rd MAY (please note the day change because of the Bank Holiday).

First Communion Weekends

Next Saturday and Sunday we will have the first of our Parish First Communion weekends. Next Saturday afternoon and on Sunday afternoon 37 of our younger parishioners will be receiving Jesus for the first time in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. The second group of 38 children will be receiving Jesus for the first time in two weeks' time on Saturday 21st and Sunday 22nd May. These Masses are invitation only, because of the limited space in the church. Please pray for them, their parents and catechists as they complete their preparations for these special days. All children who are celebrating next weekend must attend the rehearsal on Thursday evening (5pm for Saturday 7th May and 6pm for **Sunday 8th May**). These rehearsals are very important to ensure the children and their parents understand fully what is involved. If you are not at the rehearsal, you will not be making your First Holy Communion this year. I am particularly grateful to Jo Marsh and her team of catechists, who have been teaching the children and have prepared them to receive this Sacrament. Please keep them all in your prayers.

Confirmation Preparation

Our next preparation session for Group C takes place this *Tuesday 3rd May* at *7:30pm* in Hesdin Hall. We look forward to seeing you all then. It has also come to our attention that some families have not received the email confirming the date of confirmation in July this year. The information was sent out on 6th December 2021 and if you haven't received it, please check you junk mail and let Jo know.

Vocations Sunday

Next Sunday is Good Shepherd Sunday, the day we pray for priests and for vocations to the priesthood. The annual collection for the Priest Training Fund will take place next weekend. This fund pays for the priestly formation of men for the Catholic priesthood. There are currently 58 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 17 of whom are from our own Diocese, and two men are studying in Rome, also from our Diocese. Last year four men who studied at Allen Hall were ordained to the priesthood to serve as our future priests. This fund also supports the ongoing enrichment and formation of our ordained priests. Your generous donation helps ensure we can support these men who are called to be like Christ the Good Shepherd. Donation envelopes are available in the back of the church. Please take one home, read the information, and bring it back next weekend with your donation. Please continue to pray for vocations and for our priests.
