5th Sunday of Lent

Fr. Duncan writes: Next Sunday is Palm Sunday, the beginning of Holy Week, the most important week in the Church's Year. Palms will be blessed and distributed at the beginning of each Mass. When you come into the church, please collect your palm with your Mass Book and Hymn Book. At the **10.30am** Masses we will assemble outside the church for the blessing of palms and procession into the church. We will have Stations of the Cross on Palm Sunday afternoon at **4.00pm**. Please come and join us. Please take a copy of the Holy Week timetable with you today. This gives the details of all the services in our church during Holy Week and Easter. Please keep it handy for reference, as there are many changes to our normal routine. The Holy Week timetable is also available on our Parish Website. As we come towards the end of Lent, we need to maintain our efforts with our Lenten exercises. When Christ journeyed up Calvary with his cross, he fell several times. If we have 'fallen' on our Lenten journey we need to follow Christ's example, get up and carry on. It is never too late to start doing something. Don't forget there is Mass at **10.00am** each day. On Friday evenings there is Stations of the Cross at **7.30pm** followed by Mass. Don't forget each day we have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from **9.00am** ending just before the Mass at **10.00am**.

Lenten Alms

These are collected throughout Lent. This year the Cardinal has decided that the money will be used to support the Cardinal's Appeal. This year the money will be used within our Diocese to support among other things, **people living on the margins live a life of dignity**.
