Palm Sunday

Fr. Duncan writes: Today we begin the most important week in the Church's Year, Holy Week. Today, Palm Sunday, we begin this solemn celebration by recalling Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem, when the people laid a 'red carpet' of welcome using their coats and palm branches cut from the trees, to welcome Christ as their King. The note of triumph in the waving of the palm branches does not last long. Christ's true kingship reveals itself on and through the Cross. During Holy Week we celebrate Christ's passion, death and resurrection.

On Thursday, we join Christ at the Lord's Supper, the Passover Meal he celebrated with his disciples. We then go with him to pray at the Altar of Repose – the Garden of Gethsemane, from where he is arrested and taken before Pilate. On Friday, we follow the Lord as he makes his way to Calvary for his crucifixion. But we know that this is not the end, because on Saturday evening and Sunday we gather to celebrate the Resurrection. I wish to encourage you to participate in all the special services of this great week, and so unite yourselves with Christ as he journeys through his passion and death to his resurrection on Easter Sunday. Then we can really make this a Holy Week for ourselves and our parish.

Chrism Mass

The Chrism Mass will be celebrated this *Tuesday 12th April* at *12.00noon* in Westminster Cathedral. It is during the Chrism Mass, which our Archbishop celebrates with the bishops and priests of the diocese, that the priests renew their priestly commitment. Also during the Chrism Mass, the Bishop blesses the oils of the Sick and the Catechumens and Consecrates the oil of Chrism. These are the oils that will be used throughout our diocese during the coming year. Please pray for our Archbishop, Cardinal Vincent Nichols, our Auxiliary Bishops and our priests, especially on Tuesday as they gather together to celebrate the Chrism Mass. You would be very welcome to come and join us for the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral. If you want a seat, you need to arrive early! Please note that the Mass in our church is at *9.30am* on Tuesday morning.

Lenten Alms

These are collected throughout Lent. Many thanks for your donations to the Cardinal's Appeal last weekend. The total collected so far is £958.83. This year the Cardinal has decided that the money will be used to support, within our Diocese, people living on the margins live a life of dignity.
