## **3rd Sunday of Lent**

Fr. Duncan writes: As we journey through Lent, it is very heartening to see the number of people joining us for Mass each day and the Stations of the Cross on Fridays. We are making our spiritual preparations for Easter and the celebration of our Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection. We gather as the family of God in Ruislip to praise and worship God each Sunday. As the restrictions of the pandemic are easing, we are able to come together again, calling to mind the great treasure of the Mass, our love of the Mass, and the spiritual moments in our lives as memories of the reality of who God is. We gather in the presence of the Lord to listen to him as he speaks to us and then we are nourished in the great Sacrament of the Eucharist. We are then sent forth with this great gift to share it with those who we encounter in our daily lives.

Don't forget there is Mass at 10.00am each day. On Friday evenings there is Stations of the Cross at 7.30pm followed by Mass. Don't forget each day we have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 9.00am ending just before the Mass at 10.00am.

#### **Planned Giving Boxes**

This weekend the new boxes of envelopes for planned giving are available in the porch. They should **NOT** be used until the weekend of **9th/10th April**. Please check your number (same as last year), and your name as you collect your envelopes and email Anne in the office if there are discrepancies. I wish to thank all those who use either planned giving envelopes or standing orders to make their contribution to the running of our parish. This is a great help to me and the Finance Committee in planning for the future needs of our parish. I know that people are very generous in their offerings, but there may be some who wish to take this opportunity to reflect on what they give to the Church. For what it is worth, the late Cardinal Hume suggested that everyone might consider the equivalent of one hour's income as the basis for deciding how much to give each week. Many still give loose change. As you can imagine the bills for our buildings for repair and maintenance, electricity and heating are enormous and those buildings are here for you. May I ask everyone to consider how much they are giving to the Church and whether some could not give a little more by:

• Adding 25p to every £1.00 that you give through Gift Aid. Please sign up to Gift Aid if you do not already do so, or if you are not sure whether you have filled a Gift Aid Form in the past. If you are a tax-payer or make a regular donation, we can claim back the tax, which will add an extra 25p to every £1.00 at no cost to you. It only involves a simple form.

• If you could make a regular donation through Bankers Order, please complete a form, this will take away the worry of remembering your donation each week.

• Alternatively you may wish to donate through Envelopes at the offertory of the Mass, if so, you can sign up today and pledge a regular amount each week.

Forms are available in the porch, please take the time to complete or take a form home with you and return to the presbytery or in the offertory collection next week. Many thanks.
