6th Sunday of Easter

Fr. Duncan writes: Dear Parishioners, this Saturday and Sunday we will have the second of our Parish First Communion weekends, when 38 of our younger parishioners will be receiving Jesus for the first time in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. These Masses are by invitation only because of the limited space in the church. Please pray for them, their parents and catechists as they give thanks to God for the gift of His Son in the great Sacrament of Holy Communion. I am particularly grateful to Jo Marsh and her team of catechists, who have been teaching the children and have prepared them to receive this Sacrament. Please keep them all in your prayers.

This Thursday we celebrate the Feast of **ASCENSION OF THE LORD**. A couple of years ago, the Bishops returned this feast to its proper day, 40 days after Easter and the celebration of the Resurrection. The Ascension is a Holyday of Obligation when we are bound to come to Mass. Masses in our church for the feast are on *Wednesday* at *8.00pm*, and on *Thursday* at *10.00am* and *8.00pm*.

This Feast of the Ascension is a celebration of the promise of the Lord to be with us always and not simply a commemoration of the departure of the Lord. It is this promise that ensures the effectiveness of our mission as Church, the people of God, to preach the gospel to all nations. We gather as the Church in obedience to Christ. We do so in the joyful celebration of Christ's Ascension. We do so in the knowledge that he promised to be with us always. Today our task is to be living witnesses of his presence and his love as we reach out helping and supporting one another.

An invitation from the Bishops Conference

A beautiful hallmark of the Catholic faith is the profound desire to participate in the Holy Mass and share in the Eucharist. We do so with deep gratitude and joy. The Eucharist gives the Church her identity - "The Eucharist makes the Church, and the Church makes the Eucharist." It enables us to worship Almighty God, to support each other on our journey of faith, and to be a visible sign of faith in the world. This hallmark is supported and strengthened by the precept that our fundamental Christian duty is to worship God by participating in the celebration of Mass. Attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days is the greatest of all privileges, sometimes referred to as "the Sunday Obligation." The statement ends:

In the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, the Lord's Supper, the Lord Jesus entrusted to us the precious gift of Himself. With humility, we glory in being a Eucharistic people for whom attendance at Mass is essential. Looking forward to the forthcoming feast of Pentecost, we now invite all Catholics who have not yet done so to return to attending Mass in person.

A full copy of this invitation is on the notice board in the porch and also on our parish website. The Bishops have also issued statement on **Migration issues in the UK**. This is also on the notice board and on the parish website. I commend this to you.
