13th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fr. Duncan writes: After celebrating various feasts over the past few weeks, this Sunday we return to the Sundays of Ordinary Time and green vestments – the colour of hope. It is during these Sundays of the Year that we journey with Christ, listening to him as he travels around preaching and teaching the people. It is in the ordinariness of our daily lives that we seek to follow Christ in the way he asks of each one of us. The gospels tell us about various incidents in the life and ministry of Jesus Christ. Each week we listen to what Jesus has to say to us. Although the gospels were written many centuries ago, they are still relevant to us and speak to us now in 2022. This year we are reading from the Gospel of Luke.

Feast of St Peter and St Paul

On Wednesday this week, we celebrate the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul. This is a Holyday of Obligation. Masses for the Feast in our church will be on Tuesday at 8.00pm and Wednesday at 10.00am and 8pm. These two men are great pillars of the Church, two founding members of the Christian Faith. Peter, a fisherman turned leader and Paul, Christian persecutor turned Christian preacher. Both these men were transformed when they came into a closer relationship with God. As we celebrate this feast let us remember our Holy Father, Pope Francis. We pray for him that his faith may be strengthened as he leads and guides the Church.

Friday evening Mass

The Friday evening Mass will be suspended during July and August. There are a number of different things happening over the next couple of months, which will clash with the Mass. We will resume in September after the summer break. I apologise if this causes any difficulties.
