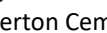

Location: the Youth Centre at Sacred Heart Church, Pembroke Road, Ruislip. Timings: **9am - 5pm** with an optional early start of **8.30pm** for breakfast. This year we have a specialist sports coach with us for the two weeks. Activities include arts and crafts, baking, science experiments and hiking. We will also have a visit from the police and the fire brigade. There will be a day trip on the Friday of each week. Week 1: The Science Museum (travelling by train).
