Fr Duncan Adamson RIP

Most of you will have heard by now that Fr Duncan sadly passed away, very peacefully, last Sunday at St Anne's Home, Stoke Newington. He was 74 and had been a priest for 33 years. We stand united in our grief but also in gratitude for his ministry in Ruislip both as a priest and a layman. We will each have our own personal memories and be thankful for his dedication and faithfulness - he always seemed to be there when needed and was an inspiration to school children, young people and seminarians. What makes this news especially hard is that there was no chance to say thank you and goodbye when he left the parish last month. However, we will have an opportunity to pay tribute to him in his funeral services, which will be held in our church.

His mortal remains will be received into the church and Mass celebrated by Bishop John Sherrington on *Wednesday 9 November* at *6.30pm*. The Funeral Mass will be celebrated by the Cardinal on *Thursday 10 November* at *12 noon*. He will be buried the following day at Northwood Cemetery. Please make a note of these dates. In the meantime, a Book of Condolence can be signed in our Church. Let's keep Fr Duncan, his family and the parish in our prayers. God bless, Fr Nicholas.

Reflection: Luke 18:9-14

In today's Gospel we hear another well-known parable of Jesus. Familiarity with the Gospels presents a challenge since it can lead to contempt and inability to listen openly to what Jesus is teaching us. Often, Jesus' teaching turns our expectations and understanding on its head and this is no different in today's Gospel. The Pharisees were held in high esteem in Jewish society, a likely model for prayer, unlike tax collectors, yet here we see Jesus present the tax collector as the hero of the parable. Jesus highlights that it is not social standing and outward 'success' which matters to God, rather our ability to open our hearts and turn them towards him in humility and recognition of our need for his love and mercy. We are reminded that if we are too full of ourselves, overcome with self-satisfaction and superiority to others, we leave little room for God's grace to work within us. So, this week as we approach God in prayer let us reflect on ourselves: • Do I trust only in my own strength and look out for myself? • Are there individuals or groups of people I look down upon? • Do I recognise that I am in need of God's mercy and forgiveness?

All Saints & All Souls

On *Tuesday 1st November* we celebrate the Feast of All Saints, a Holiday of Obligation. Masses for the Feast are on *Monday 8.00pm, Tuesday 10.00am and 8.00pm*. This feast gives us an opportunity to praise God for all those people, who in day-to-day life have responded to the challenge presented in the Gospel. We remember, with gratitude and joy, all those who have gone before us in faith and are now enjoying the reward of their labours in the kingdom of heaven.

On *Wednesday 2nd November*, is the Commemoration of All Souls, when we remember all those who have died, and 'gone before us 'marked with the sign of faith'. Masses are, **10.00am and 8.00pm**. On this day and throughout the month of November we pray especially for all the souls in purgatory
