2nd Sunday of Advent

Reflection

This Sunday marks the beginning of the second week of Advent and the second week of the church's liturgical year. The readings at Mass this week are all about preparation. 'Prepare a way for the Lord,'. Advent is a time of preparation, everyone is busily preparing for the Christmas celebrations, putting up decorations, doing the food shopping, making arrangements with friends and family, buying gifts. But Advent as a time of preparation is much deeper than this. Advent is a time of spiritual preparation where we are not only preparing for the celebration of Christmas, Christ's birth, but also for the second coming. On the outside we prepare for Christmas but on the inside we prepare for our own judgement. Advent is a 21-28 day period of penance. This season is to remind us that our earthly life should have no higher goal than preparing ourselves for eternity. Christmas is celebrated for 40 days starting on Christmas eve (the night Jesus was born) and ending on Candlemas in February (when we remember Jesus' presentation at the temple).

What can we do to prepare ourselves spiritually for the second coming?

- -make our faith a priority -Pray frequently, attend mass, receive communion, go to confession -seek God's guidance in all situations -Have trust in God even in times of uncertainty -Encourage one another and don't lose hope -Live in expectation that today could be the day

 -give what you can to those less fortunate
