Palm Sunday

Dear Parishioners

Today we begin the most important week in the Church's Year, Holy Week. Today, Palm Sunday, we begin this solemn celebration by recalling Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem. During Holy Week we celebrate Christ's passion, death and resurrection. I wish to encourage you to participate in all the special services of this great week, and so unite yourselves with Christ as he journeys through his passion and death to his resurrection on Easter Sunday. Then we can really make this a Holy Week for ourselves and our parish.

Over the last couple of months, I have reflected on the times of Masses and had discussions with the parish council and those involved with the music and singing. I believe the Sunday morning Mass times were 8.30am, 10am and 11.30am before the covid pandemic. I would like to return to those times for a couple of reasons. 1. A number of people have said that the 12noon Mass is too late. 2. I believe that the parish could have music and singing at two Sunday Masses, the folk group and the children's choir at the 10am and the more traditional choir at the 11.30am.

I hope to introduce the change for the 1st Sunday of May, the **7th May 2023**.
