First Communion Weekends

This Saturday and Sunday we will have the first of our Parish First Communion weekends, when 42 of our younger parishioners will be receiving Jesus for the first time in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. The second group of 40 children will be receiving Jesus for the first time in two weeks' time on *Saturday 27th* and Sunday *28th May*. These Masses are invitation only, because of the limited space in the church. Please pray for them, their parents and catechists as they complete their preparations for these special days. All children who are celebrating next weekend must attend the rehearsal on Friday evening *(5pm* for *Saturday 27th May* and *6.15pm* for *Sunday 28th May*). These rehearsals are very important to ensure the children and their parents understand fully what is involved. If you are not at the rehearsal, you will not be making your First Holy Communion this year. I am particularly grateful to Cheryl Gracias and all the catechists, who have been teaching the children and have prepared them to receive this Sacrament. Please keep them all in your prayers.

He lived most of his life in Italy but was born and baptised in Fulham in the Diocese of Westminster. He was born in 1991 making him a modern day saint.
