Sean, even if reference forms are sent out from the school to the priests directly.

Note: The Certificate of Catholic Practice is a statement that the child concerned is being raised in a practicing Catholic family. This means the family are fulfilling the commandments by coming to Mass each Sunday and on Holydays of Obligation.
