Please use the hall entrance and wait in the hall until Fr. Sean is available to see you. **There is no rush there will be plenty of opportunity to meet with Fr. Sean for CCP school signing on other occasions.** Please ensure you bring the applicant's Baptism certificate with you to the meeting and any school SIF forms which must be filled out in full. Please don't come to meet with Fr. Sean until you have all your school applications. All those parents applying to faith secondary schools must see Fr. Sean, even if reference forms are sent out from the school to the priests directly.

NB: The Certificate of Catholic Practice is a statement that the child concerned is being raised in a practicing Catholic family. This means the family are fulfilling the commandments by coming to Mass each Sunday.
