Please ensure you have <u>all</u> your school applications *before* coming to meet with Fr Sean. All those parents applying to faith secondary schools must see Fr. Sean, even if reference forms are sent out from the school to the priests directly. Note : The Certificate of Catholic Practice is a statement that the child concerned is being raised in a practicing Catholic family. This means the family are fulfilling the commandments by coming to Mass each Sunday and on Holydays of Obligation.
