## Pentecost Sunday

#### **First Communion Weekends**

This Sunday at the **10am** and **12noon** Masses, we will have the first of our Parish First Communion weekends when 33 of our younger parishioners will be receiving Jesus for the first time in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. The second group of 28 children will be receiving Jesus for the first time next week, Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> May and the third group of 27 will be receiving FHC on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June. Please pray for them and their parents as they complete their preparations for these special days.

All children who are celebrating next weekend must attend the rehearsal on Friday evening 24<sup>th</sup> May (5pm for 10am Mass and 6.15pm for 12noon Mass. These rehearsals are very important to ensure the children and their parents understand fully what is involved. If you are not at the rehearsal, you will not be making your First Holy Communion this year. I am particularly grateful to Daniela Bourke and all the catechists, who have been teaching the children and have prepared them to receive this Sacrament. Please keep them all in your prayers.

#### Faith School Designation Reforms announced by the Government

Last week the government opened a consultation on lifting the 50% cap on faith-based admissions criteria for new Free Schools alongside proposals on opening special faithbased academies. Clearly these changes would be great news for Catholic education. You will see the response from Bishop Marcus in the DfE press release as follows:

"These proposals are welcome. Dioceses are well placed to respond to differing local educational demands around the country, including the provision for children with special educational needs and disabilities. Parents can welcome this also. Catholic education not only provides a high performing school sector and promotes the formation of children in values and virtues; it is more ethnically diverse than other schools, educates more pupils from the most deprived backgrounds, and builds social cohesion within our communities."
