Fr. Paulo writes:-

It has been a great privilege to be present, celebrate and witness around forty of our children, together with their families, receive Holy Communion for the first time. They have waited a long time for this moment and, helped by Sr. Joanna and the catechists, have prepared very well for this moment.

Now is the time for us to witness and rejoice as our Confirmation Candidates, after a long wait, will receive this fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Confirmation. Pope Francis wrote a lovely catechises on the importance of Confirmation, some of which I would like to share with you.

The term "Confirmation,"..., reminds us that this Sacrament brings a growth of Baptismal grace: it unites us more firmly to Christ; it brings to fulfilment our bond with the Church; it gives us the special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith, to confess the name of Christ and never to be ashamed of His cross. "For this reason it is important to care that our children, our young ones have this sacrament. We all must take care that they be baptized: and this is good, but perhaps we don't care so much if they receive Confirmation: they remain half-way and do not receive the Holy Spirit, which is very important in Christian life, because it gives us the strength to go forward!

Let us think, each one of us: do we, truly care that our children and our young ones receive Confirmation? This is important, it is important! And if you have children in your home, young ones who have not received it yet and are of age to receive it, do everything possible to bring to fulfilment this Christian initiation and that they may receive the strength of the Holy Spirit. It is important!"
