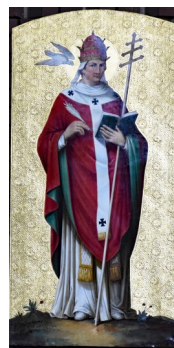

You may be all concerned with what has been said by the Government regarding the new regulations, but in so far as Churches are concerned, these are the points we need to be aware of:-

Churches can remain open, the Cardinal himself said that the Government consider places of worship low risk in so far as we all adhere to the social distancing rules.

You must book a place for your preferred choice of Mass. At least 1 person in your group should supply contact details or check in using the NHS COVID-19 app, so NHS Test and Trace can contact you if necessary. The Sunday obligation continues to be lifted so you can attend any day of the week. Week days tend to be a bit quieter. **Please wait to be seated and follow the instructions of the stewards.** You must continue to wear a face covering whilst in the church and in those areas where this is mandated.

Please wipe down the seats after you have finished, using the cleaning materials supplied.

You must not socialise with anybody outside of your household or support bubble in any indoor setting, whether at home or in a public place.

You must not socialise in a group of more than 6 outside, including in a garden or other spaces like beaches or parks (other than where specific exemptions apply in law).

Weddings, funerals and baptisms can go ahead with restrictions on the number of attendees.
