Commentary on the First Reading

The Book of Deuteronomy consists of four great discourses on the Law. This lovely passage concludes the last discourse, after which the death of Moses is recounted. It encourages the people to observe the Law. The Law is not obscure, or difficult, or far away. They do not need to travel far or search deeply. The author is saying that it is Israel's natural inheritance, and is natural for them to observe, almost – as we would say – second nature. The Law was for Israel God's most precious gift, a revelation of the divine nature and the divine ways to the world, so a source of light and life. It revealed how Israel must behave in order to be God's faithful people. So observance of the Law was not a tiresome obligation but a response in love to this gift made in love. For Christians the Law is brought to perfection in the incarnate Word of God, who is the perfect revelation of the Father, and is the Way, the Truth and Life. Israel saw the revelation of God's will, and so of his nature, in the Law; Christians similarly see the full revelation of the glory of God in Christ Jesus.
