HOLY WEEK

Look, Jesus has stretched out His hands to embrace us, come! - where? - in Jesus' arms; seek redemption, receive mercy, seek it! - where? - in Jesus' arms.

Live, die, rest here, you forsaken chicks, stay! - where? - in Jesus' arms.

With this most moving Aria from Bach's St. Matthew's Passion, want to invite us to celebrate Holy Week, to enter into the embrace of the Crucified Jesus.

"Look, Jesus has stretched out His hands to embrace us,"

We will celebrate Palm Sunday and welcome Jesus into Jerusalem, holding Palm branches, and then come into the Crucified Jesus's arms and embrace as we hear the words of the Passion according to Mark.

"Seek redemption, receive mercy, seek it! - where? - in Jesus' arms."

We will celebrate Maundy Thursday when we as a parish will receive the Holy Oils, blessed by the Bishop; we will sit with Jesus at the Last Supper and celebrate with Him the institution of the Sacrament of redemption and mercy: the Eucharist. Afterwards we can spend time with Him in prayer in the Garden of Repose, as we remember Jesus in His Agony.
