On Palm Sunday we are not re-enacting something that happened 2000 years ago. Instead we support each other in faith. We pray for each other, so that we can enter this holy week and make Passover with Jesus Christ. We gather together we make a public profession of faith, processing humbly and joyfully with palms in our hands, making a statement that we are disciples of the love called Jesus Christ. Many Christians around the world put their palm leaves on the lintel of their doors as a statement that 'in this house there are those who believe, who belong to Jesus Christ.

In Judaism to this day, Passover is a living experience of those who are slaves and oppressed and on Passover night the Lord comes to set them free. For us Christians Passover is also a living experience, where on Maundy Thursday, like Christ, we are invited, spiritually, to find ourselves at the feet of each other; a sign of humility and reconciliation. This reconciliation is then sealed in the Communion with the Body and Blood that we receive from Jesus on the Last Supper.

On Good Friday, we are invited to come and embrace the Cross, 'the Bed of Love' as an ancient hymn calls the Cross. Also we embrace and kiss our existential Cross, that experience or situation in life which without Christ would have the power to destroy us, but with Jesus we experience victory and resurrection.

On Holy Saturday night we celebrate 'the night of nights', the liturgy that is echoed at every Mass throughout the year: the Easter Vigil, when Risen Jesus comes to meet us, as the bridegroom coming to his bride. The meeting of love between Jesus and his bride, the Church is one from which new children are born for mother Church through baptism. On this night we receive our new brothers and sisters and together we celebrate the love of Jesus in the Easter Eucharist.

On Sunday the joy of the Easter Vigil echoes over and over again as we greet the Risen Lord at each Mass. These are the highlights, but there are plenty of other opportunities this week in which we can be together with Jesus and each other. See the parish leaflet for further details.
