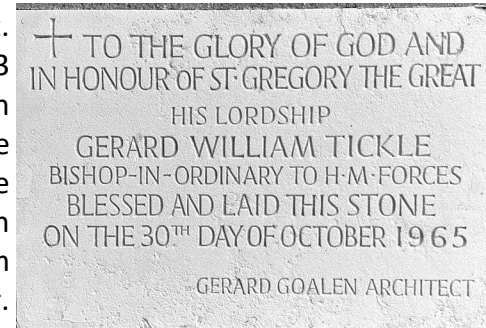

The Parish Office is closed on Thursdays.

On the 23rd October 1958 the Parish of St. Gregory The Great was founded and 2023 marks the 65th anniversary. On the 30th October 1965 the foundation stone of the Church was laid. This marks 58 years since the parish of St. Gregory the Great, South Ruislip, was created by Cardinal William Godfrey, Archbishop of Westminster. Fr. Philip Dayer was appointed parish priest in October 1958 and regular daily Mass was started for this new little community, first of all in a house chapel at 53 Queens Walk. Then in 1959 a hut was erected and used as a Mass and social centre until St. Swithun Wells' Primary School was built on the same site at Hunters Hill in 1961. This school hall then served the parish until the present church on Victoria Road was built and officially opened by Cardinal John Heenan in April 1967.



The intention to build a church was strong from the beginning, and the substantial amount saved by 1965 made it prudent as well as possible to borrow the further sum necessary to go forward with the plans of Mr. Gerard Goalen, the architect, for Church, Church hall and Priest's house. The total cost of all the work including Church furnishings, exterior landscaping, car parks and fees was of the order of £70,000. The Archdiocese was able to make a grant of £15,000. Apart from this every penny has come from direct giving and various fund raising efforts.
