PARISH CAR PARK

As well as anti-social behaviour going on in our car park for quite some time, the contents of a parishioner's van were stolen whilst they were attending Mass. To try and alleviate this, and following suit with other parishes in the Diocese, we have found it necessary to hand over the management of our car park to an outside company. This company will put up signage and install cameras around the car park. They will install tablets on which you will need to enter your car registration number when you use the car park at set times. These tablets will be located in the hall, church porch and parish office. **If you do not enter your details, you will incur a fine**, which the company will post out to you directly. They will not leave a notice on the car.
