ST JOHN FISHER

This Sunday is called Gaudete Sunday, Rejoice Sunday. This comes from the readings we hear today, and it underlines an important point. In the Gospel, we hear John the Baptist telling different groups what to do - they must repent and change their lives. We might think of this as a rather joyless thing, something which is hard and unrewarding. We might feel very comfortable with the status quo, it's working for us. The message of this Sunday is that repentance and changing our lives to welcome Jesus is something richly joyful. When we are planning to welcome anyone we love to our homes, we set about cleaning and preparing for their visit with enthusiasm - nothing is too much trouble for someone we care for greatly. Even scrubbing the bath or polishing the furniture can be a happy and joyful thing! The message of this Sunday is that preparing to welcome the Lord - even though it may involve hard work - is something utterly joyful, because of our love for Him, and His love for us. Happy Gaudete Sunday!

FR DOMINIC BYRNE RIP: It was announced this week with enormous sadness, that dear Father Dominic, Parish Priest at St John Fisher from 2001-2007, died in hospital on Monday. We pray for Fr Dominic's family, and for parishioners of St Theodore of Canterbury, Hampton-on-Thames, at this time. Mass was offered for the repose of his soul here on Saturday morning. Funeral arrangements: Fr Dominic will be received into St Theodore's, on Sunday 19th Dec at 6.00pm. There will be Mass at 6.30pm celebrated by Bishop Nicholas Hudson. On Monday 20th Dec, Fr Dominic will be brought to Westminster Cathedral for the Funeral Mass at 12.30pm with Cardinal Vincent presiding. We pray for Fr Dominic, giving thanks for his ministry and witness to the Gospel, here and across the Diocese. Eternal rest grant to him O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him.
