# T JOHN FISHER THOLIC CHURCH

The readings for the 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time -Year C, focus on the Church as the Bride of Christ.

In the first reading we hear that God's people are "espoused" to Him and called "My Delight". The Psalm is a song of praise. In the second reading, we learn that our varied gifts are all manifestations of the Spirit. The Gospel tells of Jesus' first miracle where he changed water into wine at the wedding at Cana in Galilee.

**First Reading: Isaiah 62:1-5** "Like a young man marrying a virgin, so will the one who built you, wed you, and as the bridegroom rejoices in his bride so will your God rejoice in you."

Responsorial Psalm: "Proclaim his marvellous deeds to all the nations."

**Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:4-11** "There is a variety of gifts but always the same Spirit; there are all sorts of service to be done, but always to the same Lord; working in all sorts of different ways in different people."

**Gospel: John 2:1-11** "People generally serve the best wine first, and keep the cheaper sort till the guests have had plenty to drink; but you have kept the best wine till now."
