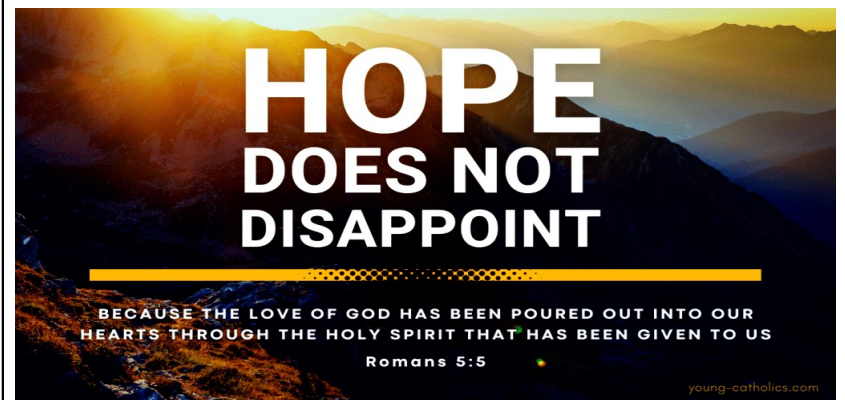


The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity tells us that we do not have a solitary God up there in heaven, far away.
