Ordinary Time 32nd Week



First Reading: Second Book of Maccabees 7:1-2, 9-14

This is one of the first expressions in the Old Testament of belief in a personal resurrection. In the face of the injustice portrayed by the violent elimination of the innocent and oppressed, Israel confesses that God is sufficiently powerful and just, to raise them to a blessed life.

Second Reading: Second letter of St. Paul to the Thessalonians 2:16-3:5

Concerned to strengthen his brothers and hindered himself by the interference of unbelievers, Paul invites the Christians of Thessalonica to pray to God with him, that the Lord who is faithful will keep them all faithful to the love of God.

Gospel: Luke 20:27-38 It is fortuitous that this passage of the Gospel is normally read near to the beginning of November, when we have celebrated the feasts of All Saints and All Souls, since it is a strong proclamation of the reality of life after death and the resurrection of the


body. This Sunday is not without its difficulties, however, since this message is framed in two very sensitive passages: we have a story of cruelty and martyrdom in the first reading, and a controversial (and possibly upsetting) question about marriage in the Gospel. Remember that the example that the Sadducees bring is ridiculous, legalistic and completely misses the point: Jesus' reply does not mean that we are not with our loved ones after death. Quite the contrary, Jesus proclaims that we will all become one with God and each other as children of God.
