Sunday 20th November 2022 **OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST KING OF THE UNIVERSE**

The readings for the Solemnity of Christ the King, focus on the kingship of Jesus Christ, who is not a king like the rulers of this world. In the first reading David is anointed the king of Israel. In the second reading Paul tells us that we are going to share in the inheritance of Jesus Christ. In the gospel, from the cross, Jesus tells the good thief that he will join him in paradise.


Jesus wasn't the king the people were expecting. The Messiah was supposed to free God's people from the oppressive foreigners who came into the Promised Land and controlled them. But Jesus was not a military commander. He did not incite rebellion against the Romans. Instead he

preached about love of God and others. AT

Jesus is our king. He frees us from fear and death. In his kingdom, we care for each other, especially the weak, the outcast, the sick, the despised, the sinners. He shows us how to trust in the Father, which is the only



way we can be truly free. He shows us that love requires sacrifice, and that the sacrifice is worth it. He is the revelation of divine love.

In the Church, Advent is a period of preparation. extending over four Sundays, before the great celebration of the birth of Christ at Christmas. The word Advent comes from the Latin advenio, "to arrive," This refers, first of all, to our celebration of Christ's birth at Christmas; second, to the coming of Christ in our lives, through grace and the Sacrament of Holy Communion; and finally, to his Second Coming at the end of time.
