WHAT IS A BENEMERENTI MEDAL?

The Benemerenti Medal is an honour awarded by the Pope for service to the Catholic Church. Originally established as an award to soldiers in the Papal Army, the medal was later extended to the clergy and the laity. Literally translated Benemerenti means 'well merited, or person of HOLY BAPTISM Please contact Fr Shaun for 'good merit.' The current version of the Benemerenti medal was designed by Pope Paul The medal is a gold Cross depicting Christ with his hand raised in blessing. On the left arm of the cross is the tiara

and crossed keys symbol of the papacy. On the right arm is the coat of arms of the current Pope. The medal is suspended from a vellow and white ribbon, the colours of the Papacy.



THIS TUESDAY, 15TH AUGUST is the Solemnity of The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is a Holy Day of Obligation for Catholics. Wherever you may be, please celebrate, by attending Mass. Masses here at SJF will be at 9.30am and 7.00pm. Thank you.
