In Isaiah's prophecy in the first reading for the 2nd Sunday of Advent, the people of Judah, exiled and longing for their homeland, are given a promise of return. This return is not just a physical journey but a spiritual realignment with God. The path back to their homeland symbolises a return to a life in harmony with God's will, a theme that resonates deeply in our own Advent journey.

Similarly, in the Gospel reading, St. John the Baptist uses language that echoes Isaiah's prophecy. He speaks not only to his contemporaries, but to us all, across the ages. Our exile is not physical but spiritual, caused by our sins. John's message is clear: repentance is the road back from this exile. As John prepares the way for Jesus, he invites us to prepare our hearts for the coming of the Messiah.
