# Sunday 3rd March 2024 3RD SUNDAY OF LENT - Weekly Newsletter -

Sunday cycle Readings Year B Weekday Readings Week 3 of Lent

Today's Gospel for the 3rd Sunday of Lent takes place in the Temple in Jerusalem - considered the most holy place for the Jewish people. This was the place of sacrifices and worship of God, who was believed to be really present in the Temple.

The presence of the merchants and money changers had turned the Temple into a market-place, which was not only disrespectful but also a distraction



from the true purpose of the Temple. Jesus recognized this and was filled with a righteous anger that compelled him to drive out the merchants and money changers.

We are called to reflect on this Gospel reading and ask ourselves if and how we might have turned our own lives into a market-place. Do we prioritize material possessions and worldly pursuits over our relationship with God? Like the merchants and money changers, do we allow distractions and temptations to take over our lives, causing us to lose sight of what is truly important?

These are good questions to ask during this Season of Lent. The Temple in Jerusalem was a vision, a prophecy, of the true Temple which is the Body of Christ. As Catholics,

we believe that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist, and that every time we participate in the Holy Mass, we are entering into the presence of God.



As we approach the Eucharist with reverence and awe, just as the Jewish people approached the Temple in Jerusalem, we strive to make our own bodies and hearts a worthy dwelling place for Christ, so that we may be a true reflection of his love and mercy to the world. Happy Lent!
