

The 4th Sunday of Lent, presents a reflection on themes of longing for God's mercy and grace, the dichotomy between light and darkness, and God's unwavering love for humanity.

recognise our wrongdoings, yet reassure us of the possibility of repentance and a return to God's grace. Through narrative of the Babylonian exile and the words of Jesus in the Gospel of St John, chapter 3, we are reminded the transformative power of belief and the hope that lies in renewal - a deeper faith and a growing relationship with the Lord.
