First Reading Acts 3:13-15, 17-19: Peter declares that by rejecting Jesus and choosing a murderer instead, the people and their leaders acted in ignorance. Jesus' death and resurrection fulfil God's prophecy. Peter urges repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

Responsorial Psalm Psalm 4: In times of trouble, I call on God, who rescues and listens. His miracles affirm, his faithfulness and his light bring joy to my heart. In his care, I find unparalleled peace and security.

Second Reading 1 John 2:1-5: If we sin, Jesus Christ the righteous, advocates for us. He atoned for our sins, and extends his mercy beyond us to the whole world. True knowledge of him is demonstrated by our listening and acting on his commands.

The Gospel Luke 24:35-48: The disciples recounted their recognising of Jesus with the breaking of bread. Jesus then appeared, offering peace and dispelling fears of his being a ghost, by showing his hands and feet and eating fish, thus demonstrating his physical Resurrection. The Risen Lord explained the scripture prophecies about his suffering, resurrection and the call to spread forgiveness in his name, and thereby affirming their roles as his witnesses - his disciples.
