- 1. 2. Ideas and discussions included:

 ✓ "seasonal " approach eg build on the current events taking place to build the community eg World Rugby Cup "view in" and Strictly theme – with some dancing (perhaps some tuition form Ceroc at Malborough School) –

Question was raised – should these be open to the broader community as well as parishioners. It was felt that others could be invited (with the annual flowers/sparkling/tea events, friends are invited) – **ACTION needs developing – Ric?**

- Requesting support from local stores in terms of goods/donations- Agreed (Ric and Sharon?)
- ✓ Ask the parish if they have an item they would sell on Ebay, perhaps they could give the item to St Barts to sell it for to the heating fund.
- ✓ During October Christimas 2023 could we have "memorial" sculpture/capsule where people purchase. This would mean that a small amount could be spent and at the same time provide a long term memorial of that person/family -*idea needs further development Deirdre?*
- Sponsor a candle with flowers on the sanctuary weekly for two families to have a person/family remembered at all Masses for a week £20 per candle (would cost approx. £5 for candle and flowers) *Fr Francis to finalise thoughts help needed. Agreed for Sept 2023*
