Dear St Bart's Parishioners and all our visitors,

2023 was a busy year for the Parish. We continued to make progress in our Parish mission" Evangelisation" - proclaiming the good news of God's love throughout the world by our actions.

We have welcomed new families in our midst and have sadly said "farewell" to some of our longstanding parishioners and friends RIP.

We set up a new Liturgy team and, working with existing parish groups and volunteers from across St Bart's, we have built upon several important spiritual and social opportunities. These involved our parishioners with new ministers for essential ministries, our local community, engaging with our Youth and St Adrian's school with specific, regular Masses and our weekly Children's Liturgy.

Our free, Monday soup lunch (after 12.00 pm Mass) has some 20 guests attending this weekly social. The monthly afternoon "Circle of Friends" social a relaxed social event, open to all. Our SVP group undertakes important work among our community.

Our annual parish HCPT pilgrimage to Lourdes took place in April after essential fundraising via our regular jumble sales, Golf Day event and carol singing. St Bart's Pantry has expanded as has our involvement with the Asylum Seekers residing locally. This includes weekly English language classes, providing bikes, bike training and support for Home Office interviews. Our new church heating system was installed along with cavity wall insulation and the entire electrical board system was replaced.
