- \* MESSAGE FROM SISTER SILVANA, CARITAS WESTMINSTER: Food poverty and social isolation are both tragedies we live in one of the most prosperous cities in the world, but so many are struggling to make ends meet, and feel connected with others. The Community Food Hub run by the parish of Our Lady of Fatima, White City is doing all it can to tackle these two great problems, but the numbers needing their help have been steadily rising. They currently serve around 100 households per week, and rely almost entirely on donations, and surplus food from supermarkets. Would you be able to do a collection of food items, as part of your Lenten almsgiving, for your neighbours in W12? The project especially needs tinned fish and meat, plus kidney beans, chickpeas, rice and lentils but they will, of course, be grateful for anything they can distribute! There are 2 plastic boxes at the back of church so please place your donations in them. Please search your cupboards and if you need help bringing food to church please let Susan know.
