I recently heard the Catholic author Joanna Bogle speak about how she smuggled Bibles across the Iron Curtain during the Cold War. I only ever carried books by Tom Clancy and Alexander McCall Smith abroad in the summer, although you might think they too should be banned. But holidays are a good time for, among other things, reading and reflecting on our lives. Thus I offer this small tome to take... There are many people involved in the life of our parish in lots of different ways, but in four areas your fellow parishioners could do with some extra pairs of hands and so I appeal to your generosity. Since you're reading this, it is most likely that you've been to Mass. Therefore, you will know that we are blessed with truly wonderful readers, old and young and every age in between. But the number is quite small. Might you have the gifts needed to proclaim God's Word? In addition, you may have noticed that we have a limited number of altar servers. This state of affairs is a total mystery to me and something I have never encountered before. Yes, the ones we have are excellent but with more we could have acolytes and the cross carried at each Mass and so on. So if you've made your First Holy Communion, no matter how long ago, think about this ministry which was once beautifully described as "being Christ's page at the altar". The third area is also something you will notice at Mass—the church around you is always dusted and swept, the benches are polished and the brass and silver are gleaming. And no, we don't have little elves that come out in the night to do this but again, the pool of our dedicated cleaners—who have been doing this since reopening after the pandemic—is diminishing. It takes about an hour on a rota one evening every five weeks: so little to ask but so much to give. Finally, the thing you won't see is the cash-counting. We have just one brilliant team but holidays and sickness sometimes make that group too small to meet audit procedures. Counting can be done any weekday so could you give a couple of hours once every few weeks with your friends after Mass, the school run or of an evening, please? These may not be the most glamorous ministries but they are vital. So do keep this newsletter, maybe as a bookmark, and think about these works. But above all, have a truly happy and blessed summer.
