I Have a Cunning Plan

Stage one is down to you as the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, 8 September, has long been your parish feast. Hence, there will be a sung Mass with the choir at 7:30pm this coming Thursday followed by a bring-and-share supper (with drinks provided) in the hall. Please indicate on the list in the porch if you can bring some food. Stage two wasn't particularly onerous—I just emailed Bishop Hudson and asked if he would like to be the celebrant and he was thrilled. Stage three was a combination of things. First, the Synodal process highlighted the desire for something in the parish for families to encourage and develop their faith. Second, I remembered how fruitful the Teams of Our Lady had been among families in my last parish and that a couple of families here are part of it. And third, I recalled Bishop Hudson saying that his family had been members of this movement. Thus, all that was required was to invite the bishop to bring his experience of these groups for family members of all ages into his homily, and to ask the families already involved here to attend and bring some literature, and hey presto, we would have something to meet that desire expressed at the Synodal meetings which could then form groups—with people to run them—for specific age groups to grow spiritually themselves and to evangelize others. In a nutshell, the team members in an area meet together once a month over a meal to share their experiences of living their family life be they a newly married couple, a family or empty-nesters. All this helps them to grow closer to each other through, if people wish, sharing the ups and downs of marriage and family life, and to increase and improve their prayer life so that they grow closer to God. In between these meetings the individual families read the Word of God, pray and celebrate the Sacraments alone and together, thus developing a simple and easily lived spiritual and practical rule of life. So, come along on Thursday with your whole family from babes in arms to your great aunt Nelly. Come and celebrate the birthday of Our Lady with Mass, the greatest Sacrament of all. Come and hear Bishop Hudson's love of the Teams. Come and meet in prayer and socially other wonderful families here and see how you can grow in your love for God and each other.
