That Sinking Feeling

When one of us goes away, the one left behind tends to do everything himself, although Fr Lorenzo and Fr Frank are within walking distance with Fr Paul and Fr Martin just a short commute away if needed. Indeed, there are a number of retired priests all over our Diocese who are willing to help out in parishes as and when they are needed. Some years ago there was concern about the vast number of priests approaching retirement age without enough going through the seminary to replace them. This problem has been long-fingered by priests' resignations at 75 not being accepted and hence we have many who are running parishes at 76 or even nearly 80 years of age. Speaking with them and a Vicar General in another diocese, these men would go on happily for years if the administrative burden of parish life was eased. In fact, the weight of "office work" is having a negative impact on all clergy and there is concern among our country's bishops about the morale and retention of younger priests in parish ministry and whether their lifestyle is inspiring to others. Of course, we must pray for and encourage more vocations, but formation takes time. Thus, the alternative is to look at places where this shortage has already taken effect. With that in mind, over the summer I spoke with a 76 year-old parish priest in Suffolk. Unlike here, there are no supply priests near him and so his holidays thus far have been a few Mondays to Fridays. Feeling spoiled and ashamed, I offered to say his Sunday Masses (he recently went from three to two) when I was at home for my break. He and his parishioners were delighted that he could have two whole weekends off in a year. And being there really struck me—everything was organised by parishioners, some of whom drove 20 miles or more for Mass while we can walk to Marylebone in 15 minutes; they were all fine about no weekday Masses for a short while; out of a congregation of 150 (we have 600), there were 10 altar servers (we have 15) and five counting teams (we have one, and almost a second). It was so encouraging. Whatever size or shape your finger, there is a gap, a role, you can fill. Without your finger, our ability to provide that which attracted us to the Priesthood and that for which we were Ordained will be unsustainable. This is an opportunity. It is not a crisis...yet.
