## **Last Chance Saloon**

You will have noticed by now that we keep the noticeboards in the porch neat and up-to-date. When I was a deacon my parish priest said that it was the first thing people see when they walk into a church and so gives an idea of how the parish is run and I've done that ever since. But you will also notice that the poster with details of the visit to these lands of St Bernadette's relics is still on display promoting stops in places like Salford and Plymouth, cities that feel as difficult to reach in these times of austerity and travel disruption as the South Pole. But it is still there because the final stop is just down the road in our very own Deanery: from Sunday 30 October to Tuesday 1 November, in the Ukrainian Cathedral off Oxford Street in Duke Street, W1K 5BQ. On a separate poster you will see that on Sunday 30 October at 3:00pm there is a liturgy in Ukrainian marking the relics' arrival and a further one called *Moleben*—a form of intercessory prayer focussed at this time on peace—at 10:00pm. Most importantly, at 6:00pm there will be Divine Liturgy—Mass—at 6:00pm in Ukrainian and English. Now for those of you who are still unsure and somehow missed Seminarian Bohdan when he was living here or haven't seen Fr Ben and I concelebrating at the Cathedral, this service will fulfil the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday as the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Rite and the Latin Rite are fully in communion with one another. As advertised, the Cathedral will remain open all day and all night on Sunday and Monday for people to venerate the relics with silent private prayer interspersed at various times with the rosary. Monday will see a further series of liturgies with a special invitation to our schools to visit while Confessions will be heard in English by priests from the Deanery between 4:30pm and 9:00pm on Sunday and on Monday from 11:00am to 2:00pm and 4:30pm to 7:30pm. So, three points. One, if you can help with stewarding throughout the visit for even just an hour, at any time, please contact Myrosia via myrosia.mat@gmail.com. Two, and I never thought I would said this, go to Mass there at 6:00pm on Sunday 30 October—it will be a real sign of unity with our Ukrainian brethren. And three, pop down at some point and sit for a moment with one who found utter peace in this world and ask her prayers for the same in Ukraine today. Fr Kevin
