Three-in-One

No, I am not about to embark on a theological explanation of the Trinity nor extol the virtues of a commercial lubricant. Rather, I refer to the three levels of the Church—the Church Militant (us), the Church Suffering (those in Purgatory), the Church Triumphant (the saints in Heaven). And these three align in the next few days thus... It's easy to understanding that we are militant, active, our primary activity being to make each day holy by worshipping God, by praying to Him. We do so with all sorts of intentions but one of the main ones, a corporal work of mercy, is to pray for the dead. And the best prayer we have is one not of our own making but one given to us by God, His work of washing away our sins through His Son's sacrifice on the cross which is re-presented at every Mass.

Now those "suffering" are the souls in Purgatory. This does not mean they are in agony but rather that they are in a place of final cleansing, a waiting room for Heaven. They can see God but not reach Him until the scars left by their earthly sins are removed. It is thus a feeling akin to the suffering we endure in an airport before heading off to an earthly paradise. And as Cardinal Newman puts it to these souls, "Masses on the earth shall aid you at the throne of the Most Highest" So, write down the names of your beloved dead on the sheets at the back of the church, put that sheet in the envelope along with your offering, return it to us, and throughout November which is dedicated to our loved ones' Holy Souls, we will offer four Masses a week for them, the prayer of the Mass, the greatest prayer of all. As for the Church Triumphant, non-stop from 3:00pm on Sunday 30 October to 7:00am on Tuesday 1 November, the relics of a member of that level of the Body of Christ, St Bernadette of Lourdes, will be exposed for veneration in the Ukrainian Cathedral. There is a notice in the porch with all the details of the services that will be associated with this extraordinary opportunity to ask the prayers of this great woman now with God for us and those who have died, for as Newman also puts it, the holy souls will also be aided by "prayers in Heaven". Don't miss out on this alignment, better than any eclipse, so that one day we might be welcomed into Heaven by the saints, among whom will be today's holy souls whose journey there we have aided.
