# **OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, King of the Universe**

To hail Jesus as King, we must possess an understanding of the nature of His Kingship. Jesus came for each one of us.

In the Gospel today, whilst Jesus is hanging on the Cross, the people, the soldiers, and the crucified criminal jeered, mocked, and abused Him. Each demanded that He save Himself to prove He was God. But the Kingship of God is eternally about the other. Kingship is perfectly revealed in the Trinity: eternal self-offering to and for the Other. The Kingship of Jesus Christ is not self-centred, but it shepherds repentant and humble souls, in His risen Spirit, to heaven.

Saint Paul, in the second reading today, to the Colossians, teaches that we gain true freedom in the forgiveness of our sins, through Jesus. This happens, as Saint Paul explains, through Who Jesus is: "He is the image of the unseen God and the first-born of all creation, for in him were created all things in heaven and on earth. [] God wanted all perfection to be found in him and all things to be reconciled through him and for him, [] when he made peace by his death on the cross". So Jesus is at one and the same time the means by which the entire universe was created; He is also the One Who came to die for each of us upon the Cross. Dearest brothers and sisters, He Who is God - omnipotent, omnipresent, omniscient - is He Who also took on flesh, took on our sin, and died on the Cross, the eternal sin offering. Stand aghast at His majesty; stand in trembling gratitude at His coming for each one of us.

The first reading from 2 Samuel 5 tells us that under King David the Twelve Tribes of Israel were united, 'and the Lord said to you, "You are the man who shall be shepherd of my people Israel". Now cast your mind back to the young David, 1 Samuel 17, slaying Goliath. Young David, who is shepherding his father's sheep, comes to the aid of the Israelite army who are quaking in their sandals at the power and arrogance of the Philistine army. David responds and acts in the faith given him by the Lord. David needs not the clanking armour of worldly philosophies to defeat evil; David opens his heart, his mind, his body to the Lord. We must do the same for the only King, Jesus. Jesus has come for us, His grace - the forgiveness of our sins - teaches us to live in a holy freedom which is victorious. Follow Him. Fr Ben
