Multitasking

Lent is a real challenge. It's not just giving something up or saying some more prayers or giving money to the poor, but it's juggling all three that's the real difficulty. So, can we do all three at once? Well, this coming Friday is *CAFOD* fast day when instead of having our usual five courses for breakfast, lunch and dinner, we have one simple main meal and two snacks and put the money we would normally have spent aside. Next Sunday we offer that money—and a little extra if we can—to support *CAFOD's* work in helping people in poorer parts of the world provide for themselves.

And to make that aid real, take 14 year old Dristy from Bangladesh. The rice crop in her village was once abundant and rich but it has been hit by so many cyclones that these days it produces hardly anything of value. In response, CAFOD trained local people to identify and source different crops that would grow in each devastated area and trees suitable to the local habitat which would shield the villages from cyclones. They then showed others, like Dristy's mother Rupali, how to build beds for those seeds and where to plant the trees that would protect against flooding. But it didn't end there because Rupali passed this knowledge on to her daughter Dristy. All of this was possible because of donations from people like you. And CAFOD is also helping with the relief efforts in Syria and Turkey. So, fasting and giving done. Closer to home, the four pillars of the Cardinal's Lenten Appeal are marriage and family life; youth & evangelisation; our education service and Caritas Westminster. Now we all know that the cost of living crisis is making daily life harder for all and that many families face the impossible choice between heating or eating. Caritas in particular responds to this by its workers putting their faith into action by serving those in such need. And for those who can't give money, your time is a priceless commodity as explained on the posters. Thus, please take home both donation envelopes or use the QR codes to donate online and if you're a taxpayer, please GiftAid your offering. More giving then on top of fasting, but add the Cardinal's pastoral letter from last week to these appeals and you have prayer too. As Pope Francis says, "You pray for the hungry. Then you feed them. That's how prayer works." Who says multitasking is hard?
