# **Everything You Always Wanted to Know About the Church...**

I was on a *Zoom* conference recently to discuss a reflection document to be later ratified by the Area Bishops' Deans' Councils before being discussed at the individually Deanery meetings: a meeting about a meeting about a meeting. And I kid you not, one other normal level of talks was omitted. Such is the life of a parish priest and dean today. That said, when we discussed it on Tuesday at the Ukrainian Cathedral (which included a wonderful lunch and special vodka about which Fr Ben can tell you more) it bore much fruit. Talking about the Cardinal's observations that we are in a time of transition and that new shoots are appearing which give "life to the practice and deepening of faith and its expression in service," and how members of the neocatechumenal way have a lifetime of catechesis, I had a thought... Throughout the pandemic, Fr Ben and I spent a lot of time on the website and Facebook page giving Scripture reflections, explanations of various aspects of the Church's teaching and liturgies, as well as the usual Masses, Holy Hours, Stations of the Cross and so on. But now with both of us heavily involved in the First Holy Communion and Confirmation programmes, and lots of couples to prepare for Baptism and Marriage, all that catechesis for its own sake has stopped and there are only adult "classes" for those preparing to be fully initiated into the Church. More importantly, having just met with the parents of the First Communion children, I was astonished at the number who appreciated some catechesis, commented how they'd never had anything like this before, and said they had learned a lot. With this in mind—and since a similar suggestion was made during our Synodal meetings here—and given that the First Communions and Confirmations will be completed by the mid-May, we have enough time until the summer to offer ten 90 minute sessions purely to help deepen your knowledge of parts of our Faith that particularly interest you or about which you would just like to know a little more. So, we hand it over to you to suggest the topics and we shall cover the most popular. But two things: one, if more of you could help with children's sacramental preparation, we could do more adult pure interest sessions; and two, this will not be a forum to discuss doctrinal

change, but otherwise, whatever it is...don't be afraid to ask. Fr Kevin
