Priest Training Fund

This Sunday is Good Shepherd Sunday and our second collection will support the Priest Training Fund. This fund pays for the priestly formation of men for the Catholic priesthood.

There are currently **48** men studying at Allen Hall seminary, **14** of whom are from our own Diocese, as well as two men studying in Rome and two in Valladolid. Last year **5** men were ordained to the priesthood to serve as our future priests.

The fund also supports the ongoing enrichment and formation of our ordained priests. Your gift ensures we can provide training for these men responding to Christ's call to dedicate their lives to serve God's people. Please be as generous as you can. In the Gospel, Jesus declares that He is the gate and the gatekeeper of the sheepfold. Jesus then speaks of the shepherd of the flock who He permits to enter the haven of the sheepfold with his flock. We see here how Jesus, our Lord and Saviour, envisages shepherds who will lead His flock. In the Gospel there is a clear bond between Jesus, the gatekeeper, and the shepherd. The sheep listen to the voice of the shepherd because he is one with the gatekeeper, the gate, Who is Jesus. In the other readings for this Sunday, we have Saint Peter preaching Jesus Christ, not himself, but only Jesus. A true shepherd, a priest of Jesus Christ, is a man who devotes himself to prayer, service, and study in order that the precious flock may be brought safely to the sheepfold, as he serves in the Person of Christ, repeating Jesus' words at every Mass, "this is my Body, this is the chalice of my Blood". Our own seminarian Robert Smialek will be ordained to the Diaconate, Saturday 10 June 10.30am at the Cathedral, after 5 years of formation; as you recall, Robert was devoted to bringing Jesus to all. This Sunday we welcome Paolo Gambardella, a seminarian at Allen Hall, who is being formed for the Priesthood of Jesus Christ. May we support the formation of our priests through prayer, by our own lives of faithful discipleship in Christ, and by financial generosity. Fr Ben
