# The Next Station is Crewe

After four years in St John's Wood, Fr Ben has been appointed parish priest of Whetstone. He will take up his new appointment in October. I am sure you will join me in thanking God for the gift he is to us and in praying that he may bring to St Mary Magdalen's the same love for God, His church and her people that he has shown here. Since July 2019, even when life was challenging for all of us, Fr Ben has only ever shown a deep spirituality and a pastoral care and sensitivity towards us all. Like you, I shall miss his delightful presence very much. Of course, given the size and make-up of our parish, another priest is needed so Fr Alex Balzanella, ordained in 2021, will join us from Watford in September. I know you will take him to your hearts in the same kind way you have done with Fr Ben and me and many others. That said, you may also know that dioceses outside London have seen a downturn in vocations and thus in priests for many years. Hence, I often cover weekends in a nearby parish when I am on holiday and those are the only times that priest can have a Sunday off without other churches and their people moving Mass times to share priests. That combination of priests retiring without sufficient younger ones to replace them has also begun to affect Westminster. Here, 39 former separate parishes are now being run by just 17 parish priests and a further four will soon be overseen by just two parish priests. This affects us as from September I shall be parish priest of both here and Holy Rosary, Marylebone, with the assistance of Fr Alex alone. As with those other places in our diocese, the Cardinal's unavoidable act of twinning will require each of us to reassess what we can expect and offer in the future. Gaudium et Spes, a document of the Second Vatican Council, says, the laity, enlightened with Christian wisdom have their own part to play, will willingly cooperate with priests and one another, and should not consider that their pastors always have a ready answer to every problem which arises. I most certainly do not! Instead, why not see this as an opportunity to pray harder for more labourers to enter God's vineyard as priests as the Gospel instructs us today, and to think what you can do to make the necessary changes easier? Yes, this may be Crewe, where as the saying goes, we all must change, but the journey and destination remain the same. Fr Kevin
