In the newsletter last week, Fr Kevin mentioned that from September our parish is being blest with a new Assistant Priest, Fr Alex Balzanella. For a number of years Fr Alex and I were formed together at the same seminary, The English College, in Rome, and so it was with some delight that I learnt he was being sent here. I always recall how encouraging and friendly he was in seminary. He was one of the few brethren who actually told the then serving Choir Master how much he enjoyed choir practise!

The appointment of Fr Alex also coincides with me being sent to Whetstone, St Mary Magdalen, as their new Parish Priest, from October. These past four years at the Church of Our Lady, St John's Wood, have been a time of such blessing; an opportunity to serve and live alongside the rich and varied tapestry of lives which, through God's eternal providence, continues to form our family in this parish. The readings for this Sunday focus on the incomparable gift of Christ our Saviour. The word gift can sometimes sound like something optional, decorative even. With Jesus, this is not the case: He is Life. These four years have helped me to grow in discipleship and to appreciate friendship in the Lord. True friendship will ever blossom anew with Jesus, "no longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing, but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you" (Jn 15:15). Trinity is eternal friendship, but without collapsing or negating the uniqueness and importance of Who the Father is in relation to His Son. This applies to all the divine Persons of the Trinity, and to our lives, too, as we are made in the image and likeness of God. Within love, within true friendship there is always order and profound respect for the other.

There is so much to give thanks for: Fr Kevin, to whom I was sent as a newly ordained priest, is always inspiring in his seasoned yet still growing theological reflections, and for his unstinting dedication to the needs of a parish, and now he has two; and to all the people of God, and Milo, who within their unique roles, have taught me so much in appreciating the eternal goodness of the Lord and how, in Jesus, our joy can be complete for He is eternal friendship. *Fr Ben*
