## The Fellowship of the Eternal Trinity Invites You

When we speak about the Holy Trinity, we enter into the realm of three divine Persons Who are eternal. They have no beginning; They have no end; They are the necessary Substance; They are Being; no thing can exist without Their willing to sustain it in its linear, time bound existence. The Holy Trinity is absolutely not part of this time-bound, changeable universe, but Their creation, which includes us, is marked with the unimaginable beauty of Their truth, Their signature.

Jesus Christ claims to be one of the Persons of the Trinity: "now Father, it is time for you to glorify me with that glory I had with you before ever the world was" (Jn 17:5). He also demonstrates His authority on earth, "Why does this man speak thus? It is blasphemy! Who can forgive sins but God alone?" [] "But that you may know that the Son of man has authority on earth to forgive sins"—he said to the paralytic— "I say to you, rise, take up your pallet and go home" (Mk 2:7, 10-11). Jesus' reference to the 'Son of man', refers to Daniel 7:13-14, where Scripture describes two divine being in heaven: the Ancient of Days, and the Son of man. Jesus knows Who He is, further, He knows why He is here.

Both the first reading from Exodus and the Gospel teach of the tenderness, compassion, kindness, and faithfulness of God (Ex 34:6); these characteristics are unchanging and eternal in God. The Son, Who has learnt everything from His Father (Jn 8:38), reveals these same characteristics by coming into creation, born of the Virgin and named Jesus, to die for our sins. The Holy Spirit, sent by the Father and the Son, (Jn 14 & 15), also reveals the tender, compassionate, and faithfulness of God, for the Holy Spirit will counsel us, will teach the humble of heart to live lives like Jesus, guided by His risen grace, for the Spirit is the Spirit of Truth.

The Scriptures teach us that the most holy Trinity, God, unseen and ineffable, has revealed Their eternal unchanging love and faithfulness by Their covenants and prophecies, and then finally in the Incarnation of the eternal Son, Jesus, and the gift of the Holy Spirit. The Trinity is eternal, unending bliss and fellowship, and They long to welcome us into Their bond. How will we respond to Their invitation? Fr Ben
