All At Sea

It would seem that my subtlety [or over-seasoning the news, Fr Ben?] may have made what I was trying to say two weeks ago a little obscure. So, for the sake of clarity the approaching storm involves:

- 1. Fr Ben leaving in October to be parish priest of Whetstone
- 2. Fr Alex coming in September to replace him—a hard task
- 3. Fr Alex and I continuing to live here but also running the parish of Our Lady of the Rosary, Marylebone

This will mean that from the end of August, your two priests will have:

- 1. Seven Masses to celebrate every Sunday over two sites
- 2. Four Masses and four sets of Confessions on a Saturday
- 3. A Mass in each church every weekday.

4. Two sets of parishioners for whom to provide pastoral care This all seems a lot but the increased workload is mainly sacramental. Ironically, this is what a priest should be doing with most of his time anyway and is not the stuff we mainly do right now. But it means we simply won't have as much freedom to do some of the nice things we did in the past at any time of the day. For example, both St Edward's and St Joseph's schools get us in at various times on different days to make a contribution to their superb Catholic teaching. This is essential for priests to do and a ministry both they and we value. But knowing our time constraints from September, each has adapted their schedules to provide a chaplaincy slot for us first thing in the morning one day a week as they know that is the one hour we can guarantee them. I feel sure you can be as understanding about our availability. Similarly it will no longer be possible for us to catechise on a regular basis on Saturdays for the First Holy Communion programme. Therefore, those kind souls who offered recently to be catechists will soon be contacted to get your CRB checks underway—please don't change your minds. In other areas, particularly the children's Liturgy of the Word at 9:00am Mass, regularly ticking Health and Safety checklists, counting etc., an increase in volunteers is more essential now than ever—so whatever you think you can do, please volunteer. This is Sea Sunday but when you see less of us, know that we're not off on a cruise and that we could be more available if you might do anything at all to share just a tiny part of our new workload.
