The Boy Bishop

In previous years I have shared alongside you in the relative calmness of the summer and the rest from the usual routine. This summer has been somewhat different not least because of taking on the parish of Marylebone in mid-August in addition to Our Lady's. It's like starting all over again. But life in St John's Wood goes on as normal—well, as normal as it gets with me as your parish priest anyway.

With that in mind, the end of your first week back at school, college or work—Friday 8 September—sees the feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the feast of Our Lady that we have adopted as our patronal feast. There will be Mass as usual at 10:00am but also a sung Mass with the choir at 7:30pm followed by a celebration in the hall afterwards to which I invite you to bring food to share while we will provide the drinks. That will also be your chance to meet Fr Alex. In 2020, the Cardinal, president of the Catholic Bishops Conference of England and Wales (CBCEW), celebrated this Mass soon after Covid restrictions had been lifted. In 2021 you had some "seasoned" old preacher [Fr Ben, I forget nothing] probably best forgotten. Last year, Bishop Hudson, who is now the representative of the CBCEW at the forthcoming Synod in the Vatican celebrated this Mass. But this year I am delighted to say that the youngest member of the CBCEW (hence, "boy bishop"), the Rt Rev Abbot Hugh Allan, will be our celebrant and preacher. Abbot Hugh's full title is Apostolic Administrator of the Prefecture of the Falkland Islands and Ecclesiastical Superior of the Mission sui iuris of the islands of Ascension, St Helena and Tristan da Cunha. That basically means he is the Catholic Bishop of the entire South Atlantic. Suddenly Marylebone seems very, very close by... Abbot Hugh is well-known to Sr Brigid while he and I have been friends for over 20 years. He is one of the warmest people I know, greatly loved and admired by bishops, priests, religious and laity alike, a man of deep faith, and great fun to boot—he will make you laugh. So please, put that date in your diary because it's our feast, and above all because it's your Our Lady's birthday and there is nothing more she would want for us to do than come together to celebrate the sacrifice of the Mass which brought her salvation and offers it us.
